Combatting Eurasian Watermilfoil

Eurasian watermilfoil is an aquatic invasive species that can grow into thick surface mats, especially in shallow areas, that interfere with swimming and boating activities and crowd out native fish and plant species.

It is not native to North America and threatens the diversity and abundance of native plants as well as the ecological balance of a lake or pond.
